## Lunenburg Arena COVID-19 Facility Protocols

### Arena Capacity/Limits

- **A limit of 60 participants for sports practices, games and regular league play.**
  - This includes players/participants, officials, coaches, team staff or club representatives, or anyone else who is required to be on or near the field of play.
- **Maximum of 150 spectators permitted.** This is in addition to the group of 60.
- **The renter is responsible for managing and adhering to the facility maximum capacity.**

### Masks & Social Distancing

- Masks and physical distancing are required at all times while in public spaces.
- Participants may remove their mask when on the ice surface.
- Coaches, volunteers, officials and spectators who are not on the ice must wear a mask.

### Dressing Rooms

- Player access must be mindful of the groups and cleaning staff before/after their rental.

### Food and Drink

- **Spectators are not permitted to eat or drink in the facility, according to Provincial Directive.**

## PROOF OF VACCINATION

### General

- **Everyone aged 12+ must provide proof of full COVID-19 vaccination (POV).**
- A person is considered fully vaccinated against **14 days** or more after receiving second dose.
  - The day a person got their second/final dose of vaccine is considered day 1. They are considered fully vaccinated 14 days after.
- Arena staff can ask to see the public's POV at any time.
- Please carry a POV with you when in the facility.

### Adult Rec Teams & Rentals

- The rental organizer must ensure all participants involved in their rental are fully vaccinated.
- All participants must show the organizer their POV.
- The organizer must record and maintain a list of all persons who have shown their POV. The organizer does not need to keep a copy on file.
- Please provide the list of names and confirmed vaccination to Arena staff at the beginning of the team's first rental.
- Anytime a spare joins your team, you must check to ensure they are fully vaccinated.
- If you are playing a team that does not have home ice in Lunenburg, the organizer must ensure the visiting team provides Arena staff with a list of participants and confirmed POV.
- The Home team must check the game officials and timekeepers POV.

### Minor Hockey and School Teams

- Follow *Hockey Nova Scotia's Proof of COVID-19 Vaccination Policy*.
- Teams are responsible to check all spectators' POV involved with their rental.

### Public Skates

- All skaters and spectators must show Arena staff their proof of vaccination prior to skating.
