



VHSHL Boys League Operations FAQ's

What is the URL of the league website?

- <http://valley.goalline.ca/>

Where can I find the league operations manual?

- It can be downloaded from the **League Document Depot** on the website. It will contain all the info required for league participation. It is suggested that new teams read the manual thoroughly.

What is the yearly entry fee for the league?

- It is \$150.

What is the league performance bond for first year teams?

- It is \$500. It is returned at end of year if conditions are met.

How long are the games?

- The games are three 20 minute periods requiring 2.5 hours of ice time. Five minute overtime and shootouts are also used if necessary.

What is the cost of admission to league games?

- It is \$5.00

Where do I get my game sheets?

- The league provides game sheets at their organizational meeting. Contact the president.

Who assigns officials?

- The referees are assigned by the league head referee. His contact info can be found under the **Executive** tab on the league website. The linesmen are the responsibility of the local assigner.

Where can I find contact info for league coaches?

- Names, phone numbers and e-mail addresses of coaches can be found using the **Coaching Staff** tab on the league website.

What do I need to provide on game night?

- Competent scorekeepers, pucks for both teams during warm-up, appropriate rink security.

Where do I send my game results?

- The game results are to be sent by e-mail attachment to the statistician within 24 hours of the game being played. The official game sheet should then be mailed to the statistician. His contact info can be found under the Executive tab on the league website.

Do I send game results to the website?

- The game score only should be e-mailed to the webmaster immediately after a game. Teams can also send along a short write-up (4 – 5 lines) if they wish.

Where do I send referee incident reports?

- Incident reports are to be sent to the league disciplinarian immediately after the game. His contact info can be found under the Executive tab on the league website.

If I need to cancel a game due to weather who do I contact?

- If a game is cancelled due to weather the webmaster should be contacted so that the cancellation can be posted and the head referee should also be contacted. School cancellation is an automatic game cancellation unless weather improves and permission is given by the principals and transportation supervisor.

If I need to change a scheduled game due to participation in a tournament who do I contact?

- The first person to contact is the coach/manager of the opposing team giving them a minimum of two – three weeks notice with hopes that the game can be rescheduled. The head referee and the webmaster should also be contacted. Last minute changes are not acceptable and the cancelling team will be asked to cover the cost of the booked ice time if needed.
